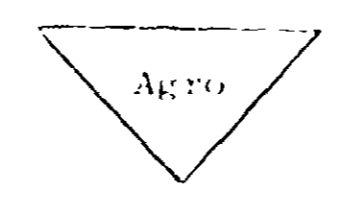

DIRECTIONS

SPRING AGRO - MOSS KILLER & FERTILIZER controls moss best and produces quick greening when applied in early Spring. However, it may be used at any time of the year, particularly when moss is a problem. Rake lawn lightly to remove loose soil, dead grass and leaves.

For normal control, apply SPRING AGRO at the rate of 40 pounds per 5,000 square feet of lawn.

If moss is a problem, apply SPRING AGRO at the rate of 40 pounds per 2,500 square feet. Repeat in about 6 to 8 weeks for severe moss infestation.



Water lawn soon after application. Wash off cement sidewalks and driveways immediately as the ferrous sulphate will stain cement.

CAUTION: Avoid inhalation or contact with skin. Wash hands after handling. Do not reuse containers. Destroy by burying in a safe place away from water supplies. Do not burn.
