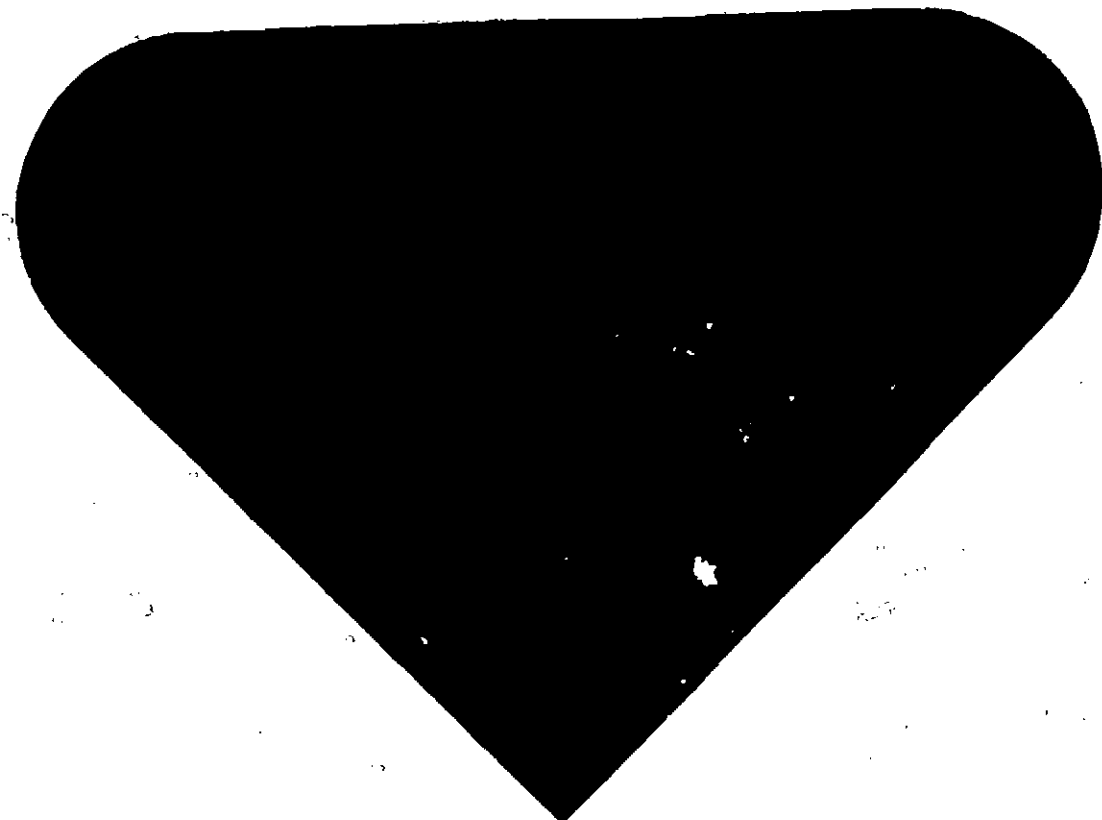

DIRECTIONS

The proper time of application is any time when broadleaf weeds are growing vigorously. Apply at the rate of 40 pounds per 5,000 square feet. Early morning application on a warm, dry day under 80 degrees temperature will allow the chemical to work and produce best results. The lawn may be dampened before application so the chemical will stick better. Do not water for 24 hours. Keep away from flowers, roses and garden plants. Weed killers will injure these plants. Avoid wind drift to garden area and keep off shrubs. Do not use on new lawns until they have been mowed several times.

CAUTION: Avoid inhalation or contact with skin. Wash hands after handling. Do not store near other fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. This product may injure bent grass, St. Augustine, carpet grass and Dichondra.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of any body of water. Do not reuse containers. Destroy by burying in a safe place away from water supplies. Do not burn.

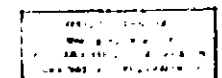
