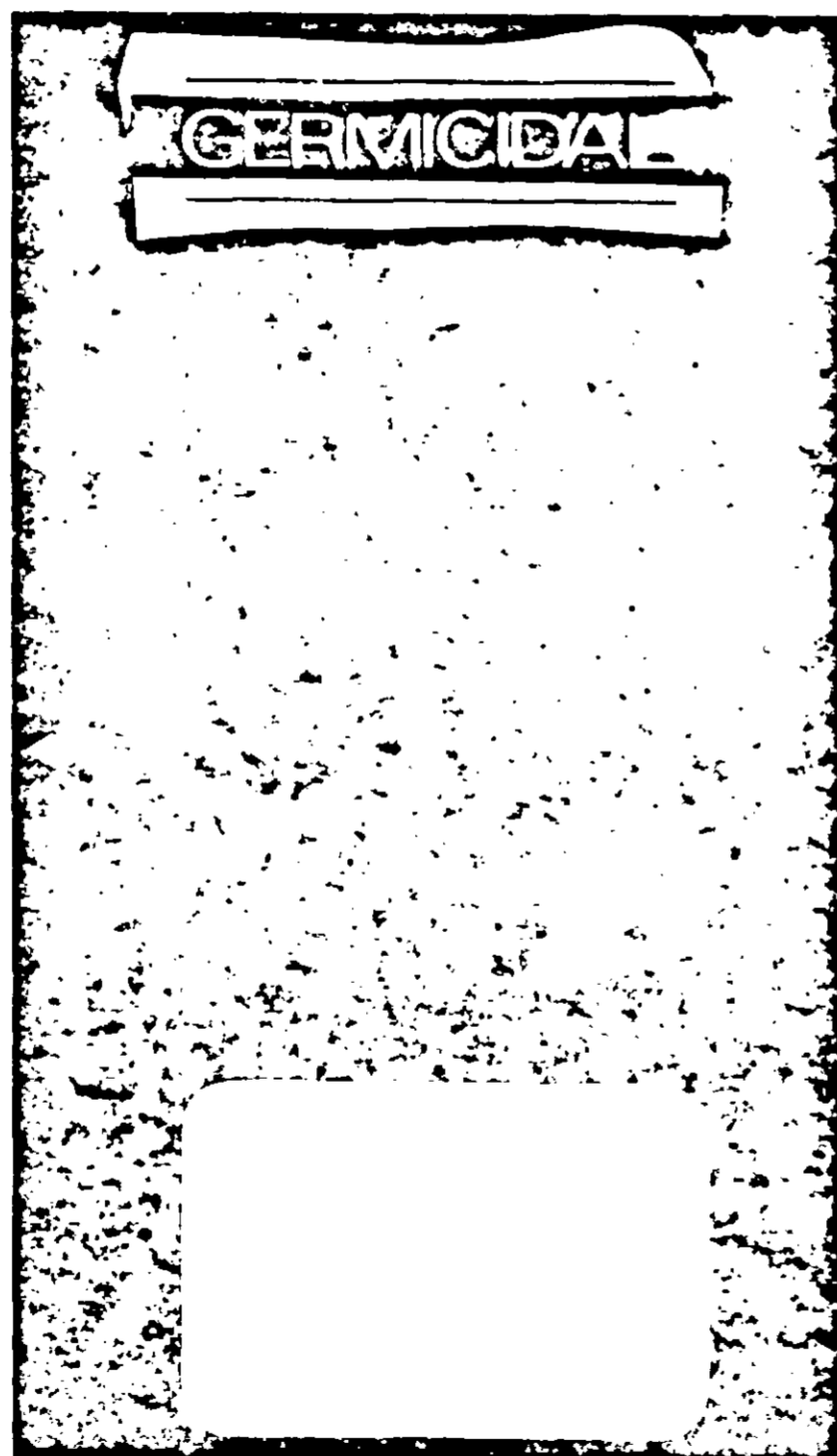

# Foam Cleaner

Lacy white foam lets you see what you are disinfecting as you clean.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

1. Remove protective cap, shake well.
2. Hold can in upright position—spray foam lightly and evenly at a distance of six inches.
3. Wipe with damp cloth; no need to rinse or wipe dry.

Cleans and disinfects most washable hard surfaces in operating rooms, patients' rooms, emergency rooms, carts, instrument trays, first aid rooms, recovery rooms, lavatory, cabinets, sinks, wash basins, stainless steel items, tile, porcelain and enameled surfaces.

Kills most disease causing germs such as salmonella and pseudomonas. Disinfects against infectious staph. and strep.

Prevents growth of mold and mildew on hard, non-porous surfaces. Repeat after 7 days.
