Directions:

1. Shake can well before use.
2. Spray area to be cleaned from a distance of 6-8 inches to cover with foam.
3. Let cleaner "work" for one or two minutes, then remove with damp cloth or sponge.
4. Heavily soiled areas may require a second application and should be rinsed with clean water to assure complete removal of all soil.

Note: If vinyl or plastic surface is to be coated with a protective finish, the surface must be rinsed with clean water and allowed to dry thoroughly before applying protective finish.
