## **DIRECTIONS:**

#### SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT, APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

INDOORS: To kill flies, mosquitoes, onats, and flying moths: Close all doors and windows. Cover or remove all exposed food and utensils. Direct spray upward into center of the room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room before re-entry. Repeat as needed.

To kill roaches and waterbugs: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes, behind cabinets, etc., where roaches hide. Hit as many insects as possible directly with the spray. Repeat as necessary.

To kill ants: Suray ant hills liberally. Spray ant trails over window and door sills and other locations. Repeat as needed.

For house plants, spray in short bursts, holding the can 18 inches from foliage for English Ivy and African Violets. Spray both sides of the leaves lightly. Do not wet. Repeat as often as necessary. Kills aphids (plant lice), spider mites, exposed thrips, lace burs.

QUES: For insects on asters, azaleas, begonias, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, question, inses, marigolds, petunias, roses and snapdragons. Also, for insects specified below on evergreens and small ornamental deciduous trees, shrubs and vines.

When sprayed directly on insites, this spray kills sucking insects: aphids, leafhoppers, spotted mites, thrips (exposed) and lace bugs. Kills chewing insects, army worm larvae, Mexican bean beetles, climbing cutworms and Japanese beetles when sprayed directly.

For best results, spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use slow sweeping motion. Keep can 18 inches from plants. Avoid wetting foliage with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat when needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.

This product may be used outside on porches, patios and in the yard and picnic area to kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats and other small flying insects. Fog the area I berally. Spray with the breeze allowing the fog to drift into shrubbery and other places where insects harbour. Repeat as necessary

WARNING: Avoid contamination of food and food utensils. Avoid cetting into eyes. In case of contact, wash thoroughly with water. If irritation persists, get medical attention. Avoid inhalation of spray mist and contact with the skin.

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame, Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator, Keep out of reach of children.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

May stain finished surfaces and fabrics if sprayed too closely
