For Control of Mold and Mildew on Hard, Non-Porous Surfaces: Clean surfaces prior to application, then spray surface until thoroughly moistened. Allow to dry. Repeat application in 14 days.

For Deodorizing the Air: Direct spray upwards, toward center of room for 3 to 5 seconds.

For Hospital Use: See use directions under "Surfaces". Walls, floors, bedframes, bedpans, urinals, furniture, fixtures, containers toilet seats, diaper pails, instrument trays, examining tables. Spray telephone and similar bedside equipment not easily subject to normal disinfecting procedures.
