1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/re-registration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

- a. Include the statement "Do not wipe surface".
- b. Indicate that surfaces must be cleaned prior to application of the product for disinfection, not "prior to use" as indicated on the proposed label.
- 3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. f.(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

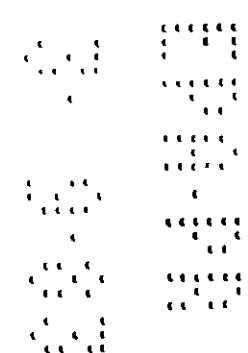

Effective when tested by the AOAC Germicidal Spray Method. This product may be used in hospitals.

SPRAY DISINFECTANT AND AIR DEODORANT

Disinfects and deodorizes surfaces through effective bactericidal and fungicidal activity. Kills most Staph. and Strep. organisms, Pseudomonas aeruginosa. Tubercle bacilli, Salmonella choleraesuis and Trichophyton interdigitale(athlete's foot fungi) on hard surfaces. Controls odors.

Clean surfaces thoroughly prior to disinfection.
For Surface Disinfection: Remove protective cap, hold can upright and spray from a distance of 6 to 8 inches until area for treatment is thoroughly moistened. Allow to air dry. ~~Contact surfaces should be cleaned prior to ~~disinfection~~~~

For Control of Mold and Mildew on Hard, Non-Porous Surfaces: Clean surfaces prior to application, then spray surface until thoroughly moistened. Allow to dry. Repeat application in 14 days.

For Deodorizing the Air: Direct spray upwards toward center of room for 3 to 5 seconds.

For Hospital Use: See use directions under "Surface Disinfection." Walls, floors, bedframes, bedpans, urinals, furniture, fixtures, containers, toilet seats, diaper pails, instrument trays, examining tables. Spray telephone and similar bedside equipment not easily subject to normal disinfecting procedures.

For Household Use: See use directions under "Surface Disinfection." Kitchens--Sinks, drainboard, cabinets, stove and refrigerator. Empty garbage cans and under bathtub, wash basin, toilet seat, empty hampers, tiled walls. Controls bathroom odors. General Use - Telephone, pet animal area, diaper pails, nursery room.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
