Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

**CAUTION**

Respirators are required or also used through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water. **SYNOPSIS AND DISPOSAL**

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.  
Disposal: Do not reuse empty containers. Wrap containers and put in trash collection.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

**INDOORS**

**To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Insects, Fleas, and Beets:** Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Repeat from thoroughly before reentry. Sweep up and dispose fallen insects.

**To Kill Cockroaches, Fleas and Fleas:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators. Food storage areas and shelves, pet crates, the suspected of being. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Carpet Beetles:** Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both sides of and surface of upholstered furniture, both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Spiders, Flies of Confused Flour Beetles, Spotted Throat Beetles, and Sawflies:** Find and destroy infested packages, pests. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Beetles, Caterpillars, Fleas and Spiders:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks and hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

**To Kill Fleas and Remove Flea Larvae:** Remove and destroy pet's bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray a pet's fresh bedding or pet's quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dog and cat with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

**OUTDOORS**

**To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Bees and Small Flying Insects:** Spray are infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Groundsweeper Fleas and Fleas:** Caution: When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill the insects listed. Caution should be taken when spraying new seedlings, ground cover, or young plants.

**WIND SPRAYING, HOLD CAN 18-24 INCHES FROM PLANT:** For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when it is still. Mist the plants lightly with a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray fans at the rate of 1 foot per second. For better growth, spray both sides of row. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperature exceeds 80°F.
