DIRECTIONS

WHERE TO TREAT

Emulsion Concentrate is applied in facilities used for storing, manufacturing, or transporting food products, it will destroy or control present insects if properly diluted.

Emulsion Concentrate is recommended for use in food machinery or around bags or bales of infested materials. It should not be applied directly on food products.

To control roaches, ants, and silverfish, spray Emulsion Concentrate thoroughly behind sinks, counters, etc., so as to wet surfaces over which these insects crawl. Treatment should be repeated as often as necessary.

HOW TO TREAT

For greatest efficiency Emulsion Concentrate must be diluted according to instructions. Areas to be treated should first be thoroughly vacuum cleaned for best results. Emulsion Concentrate should then be applied so as to wet surface over which insects crawl. One gallon treats 1000 square feet.

WHEN TO TREAT

Insects infesting food products require as little as three weeks to pass from egg to adult. Initially, Emulsion Concentrate should be applied at monthly intervals. If protective films are kept free from dust, intervals between treatments may be increased greatly thereafter.

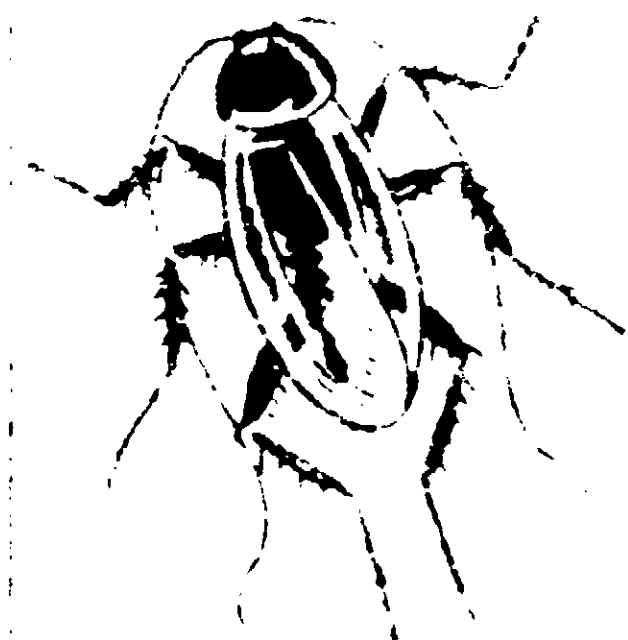
