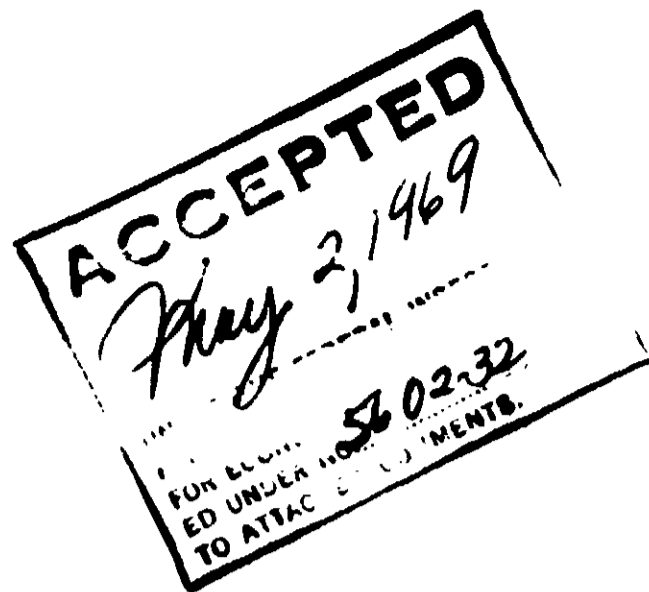

DILUTION DIRECTIONS

OIL BASE SPACE SPRAYS

To provide fast knock down properties to space sprays for small flying insects use 2% to 6% LETHANE 384 50% depending on results desired. Lethane oil sprays in excess of 4.0% should not be applied in barns.

() OIL BASE THERMAL FOGGING COMPOUNDS

To provide fast knock down properties to fogging compounds containing pyrethrins, malathion, DDT use 5% to 10% of LETHANE 384 depending on results desired.

The above recommendations are based on the concentration in the final ready to use insecticides.

Thermal fogging compounds containing 3% to 5% Malathion and 5% to 10% LETHANE 384 50% in fuel oils are especially effective in mosquito control.
