A poison for preparing rat
baits for the control of the Norway (brown) Rat

D A N G E R: KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN

P O I S O N

Active Ingredients: 92%
Alpha-naphthylthiourea 92%
Inert Ingredients: 8%
Total 100%

GENERAL DIRECTIONS: To prepare a suitable tracking
powder mix one part Hub States Antu to 3 parts flour. Dust
the tracking powder (20-25%) into burrows and holes with
a standard dust pump. Spread a thin layer of dust in
patches on the floor where rats travel.

Care must be
taken to insure that this powder is used only in locations
not accessible to children, pets and domestic animals.
Do not expose where powder may contaminate food or feed.
After completion of rodent control program, collect all
dead animals and clean up remaining powder.

Use Directions: a. Place rounded teaspoon amounts (1/4
1/3 oz.) at about 10 foot intervals where rats feed, water
or travel. b. Baits must be placed in locations not
accessible to children, pets, and domestic animals, or in
tamper-proof bait boxes. c. After completion of the
control program, collect baits and containers and destroy
by deep burial or burning (Keep out of smoke).

Mix 1 part Antu with:

- a. 45 parts ground corn and other grains or;
- b. 45 parts meat or fish, dogs and cats will actively
search for fish or meat baits, place baits where
they will not be fed upon by these animals, or;
- c. 45 parts ground apples, ground melons, mashed sweet
potatoes or similar suitable baits.

Place these baits where they are not accessible to
children, pets or domestic animals.

WARNING: Keep dogs, cats, hogs and chickens away from
baited areas. Keep out of reach of children. Bait should
be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets and
domestic animals, or in tamper-proof bait boxes. Avoid
inhalation of dust. Avoid contamination of food and feed.
Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
