DIRECTION FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

Resistant and Non-Resistant Cockroaches

Hub States D-TOX R mixes readily with water or oil. Dilute the required amount of Hub States D-TOX R in water or in an oil such as deodorized kerosene. Mix according to the instructions below to obtain the desired concentration of 0.25% or 0.50% Hub States D-TOX R. Use the higher concentration (0.50%) to quickly reduce heavy cockroach infestations, and the lower concentration (0.25%) on light infestations.

1 gal. of spray mixture . . . Use 2½ oz. Hub States D-TOX R for 0.25% concentration.
1 gal. of spray mixture . . . Use 5 oz. Hub States D-TOX R for 0.50% concentration.

Use as a spot treatment by applying as a coarse spray or with a paint brush to areas where cockroaches are normally found. These areas include dark corners of rooms or closets, at the base of walls, in cracks in walls, behind baseboards, behind and beneath sinks, refrigerators, stoves and cabinets, and around drainboards and drainpipes. Apply in a manner to avoid spray or mist contacting food, feedstuffs and water supplies. Dishes and food handling utensils should be thoroughly washed in soap and water if they become contaminated by the application of this product. Repeat treatment as necessary.

This product may be used in homes, apartments, hotels, warehouses, manufacturing plants, recreation buildings and similar areas. This product may not be used in animal buildings, poultry houses or in the edible products area of food processing plants.

NOTE: A period of four to seven days after treatment is normally required for maximum effect on cockroaches.

Cinch Bugs and Red Winged Blackbirds in lawns and turf.

Apply D-TOX R at the rate of 2½ oz. diluted in 30 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. of area. Apply uniformly when the insects first appear. Repeat as necessary. The lawn should be moist at time of application. Keep children and pets off treated area until spray has dried.
