Always use a good insecticide sprayer designed for the specific application. Spray into space to kill flying insects. Spray surfaces as directed to kill crawling insects. Follow directions for best results.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, BEETLES, CRICKETS, SPIDERS, TICKS, CENTIPEDES. Apply directly into infested areas and onto infested surfaces. This product must have direct contact with the crawling pest. Where possible spray heavily all cracks, crevices, under carpets, tanks, air and drains, floors, and any place where these pests crawl, nest or breed. Repeat weekly or as needed to maintain lasting control.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray along ant trails to nests, porch landings, building supports, foundations or the sides of the house up to window level. Spray into all openings from which the ant emerges. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS. Discharge spray mist into corners, under furniture and upward in center of rooms. Keep room closed for at least 10 minutes.

TO KILL CLOTHES MOTHS Remove and examine garments. Spray closet walls, floor, thoroughly. Spray clothing completely, under each button, seam. Keep sprayer 3-foot away. Repeat as needed.

TO KILL BEDBUGS: Spray to top of mattress liberally, especially tufts and seams. Disassemble bed, spray joints. Also spray walls, baseboards, window frame. Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS INFESTING PREMISES can be controlled quickly and effectively by spraying floors and cracks of the infested areas. Fleas seek in carpets and upholstered furniture. Spray liberally in these areas, as well as in baseboards, wall cracks and sleeping quarters of animals for direct contact with these pests. Repeat as necessary.

STORED PRODUCTS INSECTS, WEEVIL, CADELLE AND CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, FLOUR MOTHS: These can be controlled when in the exposed or accessible stages by the following treatment. Floors, walls and partitions in flour mills and feed mills should be sprayed with enough solution to wet the surface, paying attention to cracks and crevices where insects may be harbored. When reinfestation occurs, repeat the application.

For space spraying, adjust the nozzle faucet lever to the position shown to produce a very fine cloud of mist. **FOR BEST RESULTS BEFORE SPRAYING, CLOSE ALL OPENINGS AND TURN OFF AIR CONDITIONING AND VENTILATING SYSTEMS.**

DIRECTIONS FOR FOGGING INDOORS FOR EXPOSED STAGES OF ROACHES, CRICKETS AND ANTS: After closing all air currents and extinguishing all pilot lights, use FOG OR SPRAY at the rate of 2 oz. per 1,000 cubic feet of space, first directing the fog nozzle close into cracks and crevices and then walking down the center of the room directing the fog upwards at walls and ceilings as well as swaying the nozzle from side to side to blanket the entire cubical contents of the room. Length of exposure time is 1 hour with windows and doors closed. After this exposure time, the room should be ventilated at least 1 hour before re-entering, then sweep up and destroy all dead and dying insects.

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

Do not spray around open flame, plant life, food, fish bowls. Keep out of direct sunlight.
