DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IN NON-RESIDENTIAL FOOD HANDLING AREAS OF: bakeries, food plants, restaurants, caterers, grocery stores, food handling establishments and in milk handling areas of milk, cheese, and ice cream plants.

Holding dispenser upright, point valve in desired direction and turn dispenser handle to spray.

MOSQUITOES, FLIES, GNATS: Close all doors and windows. Direct the spray to all parts of the room. Fill the room with mist then leave the treated area. Keep room closed for at least 15-30 minutes. Do not remain in treated area. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

WASPS: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

Disposal: This Cylinder is refillable; return to manufacturer for deposit or Exchange when empty.

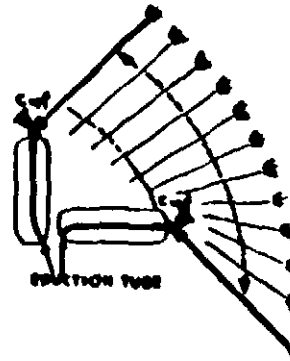

How To Assemble and Operate The

CONTAINER - APPLICATOR

How To Assemble:

1. Remove cap "A" from cylinder valve.
2. Attach the applicator "B" to the valve with slight pressure from a wrench if necessary.
3. Do not use without Applicator "B".



How to Operate:

- (1) This is the range of correct operating positions.
- (2) Do not invert the cylinder.
- (3) Keep hand wheel "C" in upward position.
- (4) One half turn releases flow.
