The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.


In accordance with the Resmethrin Registration Standard, modify the label declaration for resmethrin in Reg. No. 5602-170 to read: "Resmethrin".

For Reg. Nos. 5602-167, 5602-169, and 5602-170, delete the active ingredient label declarations of "petroleum hydrocarbon oil base", "aromatic petroleum hydrocarbons", and "petroleum distillates" from the respective labels and add the corresponding percentages to the inert ingredients. The phrase --"Contains petroleum distillates"-- should then be added as a substatement to the ingredient statement. If you choose not to include these petroleum derivatives as inert ingredients, you are responsible for any data required to support their reregistration as active ingredients.

Delete the term "related compounds" from the label ingredient declaration for Reg. Nos. 5602-169 and 5602-170. Unless otherwise substantiated, these compounds should be considered inert. If the "related compounds" are determined to be active, they should be incorporated in the declaration for the active ingredient and not distinguished as "related compounds" or "other isomers".

Please be advised that several ingredients in your products have been identified as Class I or Class II substances under Title VI of the Clean Air Act, 1990 Amendments. Based upon this Act, Congress has implemented provisions to protect the stratospheric ozone layer from deterioration. Please review PR Notice 92-3 for further guidance. Any questions concerning this issue are welcomed by the Agency.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

NON-RESIDENTIAL FOOD-HANDLING AREAS OF: bakeries, food plants, restaurants, delicatessens, grocery stores, food handling establishments and in milk handling areas of milk, cheese, and ice cream plants.

Holding dispenser upright, point valve in desired direction and turn dispenser handle to spray.

MOSQUITOES, FLIES, GNATS: Close all doors and windows. Direct the spray to all parts of a room. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep room closed for at least 15-30 minutes. Do not remain in treated area. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

WASPS: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally in hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.
