- 2 Cham cylinder to cart.
- 3 Affix the hose and applicator to the valve with slight pressure from a wrench.

**How to assemble and operate SA-2 SOLENOID VALVE**

1. Attach SA-2 solenoid valve to cylinder with slight wrench pressure. NOTE: Valve should be attached in inverted position. Open cylinder valve 2 turns — check for leaks.
2. Invert cylinder and slide handles into bracket slots. Tighten hold plate over handle with wing nut.
3. Use at a rate of 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet.
4. When utilizing SA-2 triple nozzle automatic valves set application time to correspond with dosage recommendation chart from manufacturer.

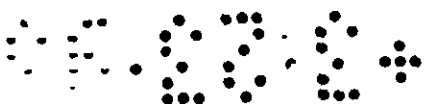
