This water-base formula has no odor - is non-staining and won't ruin rugs, drapes or floors.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a violation of Federal law to use in a manner inconsistent with it.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or storage or disposal. Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or flame. Disposal: Replace cap and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

Use one canister for each 5,000 cu. ft. of obstructed area. Example: 25' x 20' x 10' high = 5,000 cu. ft. Use additional units in remote rooms or where free flow of air is not assured. Do not use in an area where people are present.

PREPARATION: Cover exposed food and food handling equipment. Cover doors to areas to be treated. Turn off air conditioners. Put out all open pilot lights. Remove pets and cover fish bowls with paper, or remove them. Close exterior doors and windows.

TO START FOGGING: Place fogger in center of area, at least 6 feet from wall. Place several sheets of newspaper under canister to protect surface. Hold can at arms length pointing away from face and eye. Push finger pad until it locks - this action. Set canister in upright position, etc. and leave building at once.

DO NOT RE-ENTER BUILDING for 24 HOURS, then open exterior doors and allow to air for one hour before re-entering. If additional units are used or where free flow of mist is not assured, allow additional airing-out time accordingly.
