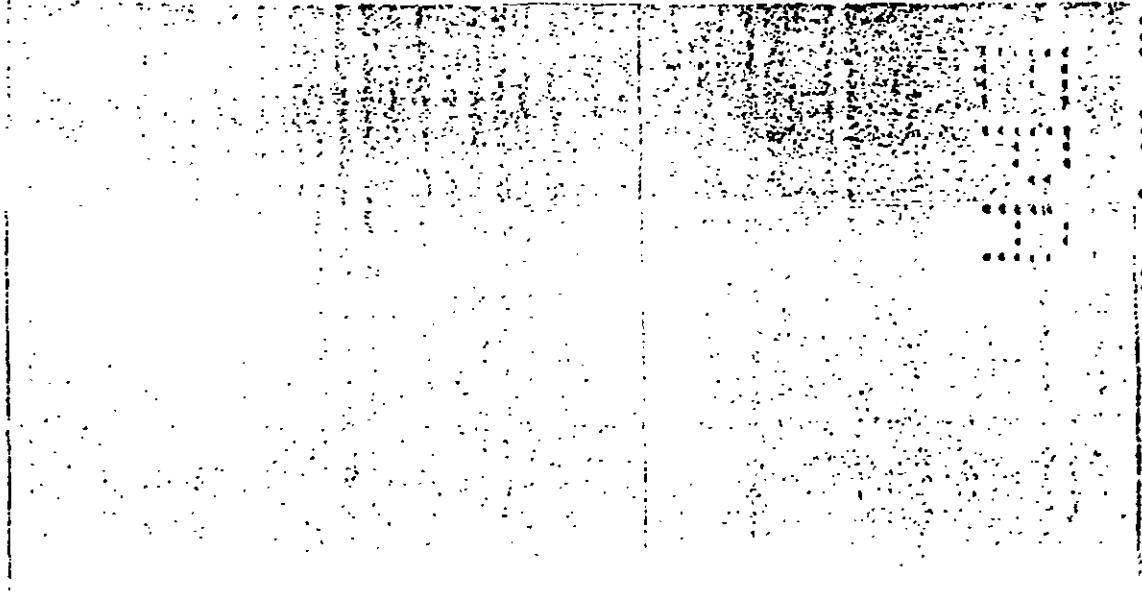

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL: This product is designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers which produce particles of aerosol size, such as the FLO-ON or MICRO-GEN.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

FOR USE IN HOMES, RESTAURANTS, FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS AND OTHER INDUSTRIAL AREAS. Space Spray Undiluted - To Kill Gnats, Houseflies, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Using a cold fog generator, apply at the rate of one-half (.5) ounce per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upwards toward upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Repeat as necessary.

Space Spray - Diluted for Ordinary Mechanical Fogging Equipment - To Kill Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Gnats. Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Dilute Concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 3 parts of oil and mix well. Apply at the rate of 50 fl. oz. of dilute spray (0.4 gal.) per 25,000 cu. ft. of space. Direct fog upward towards upper corners of room and ceiling area. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry.

Contact Spray - Undiluted - To Kill Black Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Confused Flour Beetles, Indian Meal Moth Larvae, Rice Weevils and Saw-toothed Grain Beetles. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilation equipment. Using a cold fog aerosol generator, direct discharge into areas suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. Spray until treated surfaces are moist with deposit. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Repeat as necessary.

Contact Spray - Diluted for Use with Sprayers that Give Large Wetting Spray Particles to Kill Cockroaches and Accessible Stages of Granary Insects - Caddisflies, Confused Flour Beetles, Grain Mites, Granary Weevils, Indian Meal Moth Larvae and Adults, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Rusty Grain Beetles and Saw-toothed Grain Beetles. Cover or remove exposed food and close room as described above. Dilute Concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 5 parts of oil and mix well. Spray out on walls of grain bins, flooring, about base of milling machinery, walls and baseboards, areas beneath casework, around pipes and other insect harbourages using 1 gal. of spray per 1,000 sq. ft. of surface. Force spray into all cracks and crevices. Repeat applications as necessary.

NOTE: When using oil as the carrier, an odorless light petroleum hydrocarbon as defined by CFR Title 21 - 172.884 should be used for all food and food related applications. Additionally, when diluted and used according to label directions, this spray will meet specifications for use under the American Laundry Pesticide Egg Grading and Egg Products Inspection Program.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water supply or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Dispose of surplus from the use of this product in accordance with the label directions.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: This container is to be recycled or disposed of in accordance with the label directions or by other approved methods and procedures.

Pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Health Administration and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health. Provisions of 30 CFR Part 11. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. In case of contact, wash with plenty of water. Wash with soap and warm water after use. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not apply space spray while food is being processed. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly clean processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc., that food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination.

When using in animal housing areas, do not apply directly to food, feed, or supplements. Do not apply directly to animals. Wash teats of dairy animals before milking.

Remove pet birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
