PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries, and other food processing plants, all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled should be washed with an effective cleaning compound and then rinsed with potable water to remove all traces of contamination. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic animals. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

To Kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, and Gnats: Close all doors and windows and direct the spray upward into center of the room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate the room thoroughly before reentry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sowbugs, Centipedes, Firebrats, and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
