CAUTION

IN HOSPITALS: Patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for 2 hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation. FOOD AREAS OF FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS: Do not apply while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, SANDFLIES, AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Ascertain the cubic feet of space to be treated. Close all doors and windows. Pointing nozcle upward, direct the aerosol mist to all parts of the room expecially around window frames and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in continuous motion at least 36 inches from fabrics. Apply for two seconds per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for fitteen minutes after each treatment. Do not remain in treated area, ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

OUT OF DOORS: For temporary protection from mosquitoes and flies spray along ground and weeds and brambles around the area. Do not spray ornamental shrubbery. Frequent repeated applications may be necessary. SILVERFISH, ANTS WATERBUGS, SCORPIONS, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS, FIREBRATS, ROACHES AND CRICKETS: Ascertain square feet of space to be treated. Open all doors, cabinets, closets, etc. Direct the mist toward insects, into cracks, crevices, and trails on door sills and window frames. For initial clean up apply for 10 or 15 seconds per 100 square feet of floor space. Follow up with periodic applications as a space aerosol at 3 to 5 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Close room for one hour. Do not remain in treated area; ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Repeat treatment as necessary. Do not spray directly on clothes, fabrics, or other materials. FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICK: Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor covering. Do not remain in treated area; ventilate the area after treatment is

completed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Concurrent treatment of animals with an approved insecticide is recommended. Repeat treatment as needed.

TO KILL BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses thoroughly, expecially around seams and tufts. Spray bedstead, baseboards and floor boards. Repeat as needed.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholestered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

STORED PRODUCT INSECTS (accessible stages)

FLYING MEDITERRANEAN FLOUR MOTHS, INDIAN MEAL (CHOCOLATE) MOTHS, ANGOUMOIS GRAIN MOTHS: Close doors and windows. Direct aerosol mist to all parts of the room, especially into dark enclosures and around product containers where adult moths may be resting. Use a minimum treatment of 6 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 30 minutes after each treatment. Do not remain in treated area, ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Repeat treatment weekly or as flying moths appear. Infested stored food products should be fumigated or treated with an aproved product.

CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAWTOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS AND GRANARY WEEVIL: Direct treatment toward insects into cracks, crevices, around machinery, around containers of stored products and other areas that may harbor insects. Hit as many insects as possible. A minimum of 10-15 seconds treating time per 100 sq. ft. of floor space is recommended leaving treated area tightly closed for at least 45 minutes. Do not remain in treated area; ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Repeat treatment as required.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
