

[HOW TO APPLY]

Shake well before using. Hold container upright. Apply in short bursts.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Sandflies, Flying Moths:

Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a low, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cu. ft). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Vacate premises. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

To Kill Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Ants, Scorpions, Centipedes, Sowbugs, Spiders, and Firebrats:

Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails around windows and door sill and other locations. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Clothes Moths:

Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior of storage container such as closets, chests and trunks regularly. Treatment should be repeated every thirty days unless the articles are stored in moth-tight containers.

To Kill Bedbugs:

Spray mattresses thoroughly, especially around seams and tufts. Spray bedstead, baseboards and floorboards. Repeat as needed

To Kill Carpet Beetles:

Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles and Rice Weevils:

Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks:

Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after the spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

To treat carpets, spray at the rate of one square foot per second. Repeat as necessary.
