2. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 5602-194" to the label prior to releasing the product for shipment.
3. The product associated with EPA Registration Number 10807-3 is acceptable as a "Me-Too" reference for the proposed product listed above. However, products 1021-753 and 1021-754, which have been referenced for acute toxicity data on the submitted data matrix, are not acceptable "me-too" references. 4. The proposed product use pattern can not contain additional pests which are not declared on the "me-too" label. Delete the additional pests which appear on the proposed product label, and submit the revised label to complete the record.
5. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash with soap and water after use. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

Do not apply while food processing is underway. Cover or remove all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, etc., all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

To Kill Gnats, Hornets, Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Sandflies, Small Flying Wasps, Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into the center of the room with a low, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cu. ft.). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Vacate premises. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry.

To Kill Ants, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Waterbugs: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting directly as many insects as possible. Spray ant hills and trails around windows and door sills and any other location ants are seen. For fleas, thoroughly spray animal quarters and sleeping areas. Pets should be treated with a registered product for control of ticks and fleas before reentering treated areas. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles, Clothes Moths: Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior of storage containers such as closets, chests and trunks regularly. Treatment should be repeated every thirty days unless the articles are stored in moth-proof containers.
