CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation. Do not apply directly to food. Cover or remove food prior to treatment. - **FLIES MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, SANDFLIES, AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS:** Ascertain the cubic feet of space to be treated. Close doors and windows. Pointing nozzle upward, direct the aerosol mist to all parts of the room especially around window frames and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in continuous motion at least 36 inches from fabrics. Apply for one second per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for fifteen minutes after each treatment. Do not remain in treated area, ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.
