DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash before use. Cover or remove exposed food.

Hub States CIK may be used as a crack and crevice treatment or as a spot application in non-food/feed areas. All areas where insects hide or through which insects may enter should be treated.

For use in non-food/non-feed areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Do not apply this product in occupied patient rooms or in any rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Do not apply to surfaces that may be harmed or stained by water.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Hub States CIK provides effective control of pests in and on buildings and structures and their immediate surroundings and on modes of transport. Permitted areas of use include, but are not limited to: apartment buildings, homes, hotels, hospitals, nursing homes, schools, industrial buildings, laboratories, mausoleums, private residences, utilities and the non-food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, and on: vessels, railears, aircraft (eargo areas only), buses, trucks and trailers.

Surface Spray Application: Remove protective cap. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. Spray surface until slightly wet (at a rate of 4 ounces product to treat approximately 25 square feet of surface area).

Crack & Crevice Injection: Remove protective cap, hold container upright and attach injection tube for injecting into cracks and crevices where insects may be hiding, living and breeding. Place injection tip ½ inch into cracks, crevices, holes and other small openings where insects may be a problem. Release a one-second spray per spot. In scrious infestations, if possible, place spots approximately 12 inches apart. In light infestations or for preventative treatment, place spots approximately three feet apart. In long running cracks, move the injector tip along the crack while spraying. Move at the rate of one linear foot per second in heavy infestations, and three feet per second in light infestations. See the additional directions below for effective control of specified insects.

INDOORS:

Cockroaches (including adult and immature stages of both non-resistant and organophosphate and carbamate resistant strains),
Ants, Booklice, Boxelder Bugs, Centipedes, Crickets, Dermestids, Firebrats, Fleas, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Ticks
and Waterbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around
drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible.

Ants: Spray freely around ant traits, doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and spray freely on and around debris.

Carpenter Ants: For effective control, locate and treat nests and surrounding areas. Apply around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises and where they crawl and hide. Inject into wall voids and infested wood through existing openings or newly drilled small holes.

Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas IN BUILDINGS: Apply to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices; under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, between and under cushions of upholstered furniture and other areas where these pests may be present. Remove old bedding of pets and replace with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Do not use directly on pets.

Spiders: Apply along and behind baseboards, to window and door frames, corners, pipes, storage localities, attics, crawl spaces and other areas over which these pests may crawl.

Centipedes, Eurwigs, Ground Beetles, Millipedes, Mole Crickets, Pillbugs, Sowbugs, Scorpions and Ticks: Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may enter premises. Treat baseboards, storage areas and other locations where these pests are found.

PANTRY PESTS - Grain Beetles (Rusty, Merchant and Saw-toothed), Flour Beetles (Red and Confused), Chocolate Moths, Cigarette Beetles, Clover Mites, Cluster Flies, Drugstore Beetles, Elmleaf Beetles, Rice Weevils, Lesser Grain Borers, Spider Beetles and Tobacco Moths. Treat exposed stages. Remove all foodstuffs, utensils and shelf paper from area to be treated, Discard used shelf paper and any infested foodstuffs. Apply spray to shelves and in cracks and crevices behind and under cupboards and cabinets, around processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers or other areas where these insects tend to congregate, Allow spray to dry prior to replacement of food and utensils. Dispose of infested stored food products in the home.

Carper Beetles' (Black, Furniture and Varied): Spray on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other localities where these insects are found.

Webbing, Clothes Moths: Use this product as a crack and crevice treatment in closets and other storage areas where these pests are found. This is an adjunct treatment and will not control moth larvae already on clothes. Do not apply to clothing.

OUTDOORS:

Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Centipedes and Silverfish. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for best control.

Fire Ants: To treat mounds, use soil injector. To maximize spray distribution, insert injector into the mound full length if possible, inject the mound at 5-6 sites at a rate of 5-10 seconds spray per site. For very large mounds (over 36 inches in diameter), increase the number of injection sites. Space injection sites in a circular pattern on the mound surface with one site in the center. To quiet active ants on mound surface, sweep surface with spray from a distance of 18 inches. For best results, apply in cool weather or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.

Pests On Outside Surfaces Of Buildings: For control of building infestation due to Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to) screens, window frames, caves, porches, patios, garage and refuse dumps.

Localized Treatment of Wood-Infesting Insects: Beetles and Borers (such as the following families: Anobilidae, Bostrichidae, Buprestidae, Cerambycidae, Lyctidae, Oedemeridae, Sestidae), Carpenter Bees, Termites and Wood Wasps: Locate area of infestation and/or insect tunnels and cavities. Using a crack & crevice tip, spray into tunnels, galleries and inaccessible closed voids. In infested areas, drill small holes eight to ten inches apart to insure thorough insecticide gallery treatment. Be sure not to contact electrical wiring or plumbing when treating. For Carpenter Bees, seal the entrance holes with small pieces of stainless steel wool after application.

The purpose of such applications of Hub States CIK is to kill workers or winged reproductive forms which may be present in the treated channels at the time of treatment and to impart a temporary resistance at these places of attack which may aid in the prevention of immediate reinfestation. Such applications are not a substitute for mechanical alteration, soil treatment or foundation treatment but are merely a supplement.
