DIRECTIONS FOR USE TO MAINTAIN CLE

1. Add 1 lb. of crystals to 10,000 gallons of water.
2. Allow 1 hour for crystals to dissolve.
3. Repeat at weekly intervals.
4. For shock treatment, add 1 lb. of crystals per 1,000 gallons of water.
5. Repeat at weekly intervals.

ESTIMATING POOL

1. Measure length and width of pool.
2. Multiply length by width by 7.5 to get volume in gallons.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE TO MAINTAIN CLEAN, SANITARY SWIMMING POOLS

Note: One level capful holds 1-2 ounces of Chlorine Crystals.

SWIMMING POOL SANITATION: State and local health regulations usually require 0.5 to 1.0 ppm residual chlorine in pool water. Apply 1 oz. of chlorine crystals daily to each 5000 gallons of water through the pool water circulation system or by sprinkling over the pool water surface. Increases in temperature, sunlight, organic matter (such as leaves, grass, air borne matter, etc.) and bathing and may necessitate more frequent dosages. For a variety of varying conditions, it is recommended that treated pool water be tested with a test kit several times a day. Repeat above dosage as often as needed to maintain 0.5 to 1.0 ppm residual. Under extreme conditions, it may be necessary to repeat the recommended dosages several times in one day. Test kits are available at your Farmingdale Chlorine Crystals dealer. Maintains a pH range of 7.2 - 7.6.

ESTIMATING POOL CAPACITY

RECTANGULAR Capacity in gallons equals length x width x average depth in feet x 7.5
ROUND Capacity in gallons equals diameter x diameter x average depth in feet x 5.875

DANGER: Fatal or Harmful if Swallowed. Strong Oxidant. May produce severe chemical burns. Fire may result from contact with heat, oil, organic or combustible matter. Do not get on skin or in eyes. In case of skin and eye contact, flush with plenty of water. If skin irritation persists, get medical attention.

ANTIDOTE: For Burns - Wash thoroughly with water. For eyes, get prompt medical attention. Ingestion - Drink plenty of water. Get physician immediately. Avoid use or storage in or around children's toys. Do not allow treated effluent to be discharged into lakes, streams, rivers, etc.

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by burying it with waste or burning. Stay away from smoke or fumes.

Do not use as a disinfectant. Use a CLARIFIER to keep your pool water clear.

Do not use in hot tubs, spas, or other enclosed water areas. Do not use in swimming pools.

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
