

Cadmium Lawn Fungicide is a liquid cadmium compound, soluble in water, which will control and prevent turf diseases in Kentucky Blue, Merion, Fescue, Bent and Zoysia lawns. It may be applied without fear of injury or discoloration to newly seeded areas as well as established lawns.

DIRECTIONS: Diseases which occur during April and May when wet cool weather prevails and diseases which occur during hot summer months from mid-June to mid-August may be controlled by using 2 oz. (4 tablespoonsful) of Fungicide in 3 to 5 gallons of water per 1000 sq. ft. Note: The amount of water is not critical as long as the proper amount of Fungicide is applied. If a pressure type sprayer (type carried on back) is used, wear an appropriate respiratory mask. Repeated applications are necessary for disease control which is usually obtained after 3 applications. There is no noticeable control after one treatment. Applications should be from 7 to 10 days apart

Total Cadmium (Cd) 6.1%

NET CONTENTS
1 PINT LIQUID

Controls: Dollar Spot, Leaf Spot,
Fading Out, Brown Patch, Pythium
Blight and Snow Mold.

IMPORTANT: 1. Normal rainfall following application will not affect results. 2. Keep lawn mowed at 1 to 1½ inches during treatment. 3. Cadmium Lawn Fungicide will prevent and control diseases only. It will not kill or affect weeds. 4. Spraying equipment should be cleaned after use.

CAUTION: If spilled on skin, wash off immediately with water. May be fatal if swallowed. Wash off thoroughly after handling. Do not breathe spray mist. If pressure type sprayer (type carried on back) is used, wear appropriate respirator.
