DIRECTIONS FOR USE TO MAINTAIN CLEAN

SWIMMING POOL SANITATION: Chlorine Tablets dissolve over completely upon contact with pool water as does granular calcium hypochlorite. Public pools usually require 0.6 to 1.0 ppm residual chlorine in public pool water. The recommended dosage is 17 to 18 chlorine tablets per 5,000 gallons of water, or approximately 1 oz. Increases in temperature, sunlight, organic matter, and bathing load may necessitate the re-application of the given dosage to maintain the proper chlorine level. For accuracy under varying conditions, it is recommended to test the water with a test kit several times a day. Repeat above dosage as often as necessary to maintain proper chlorine level. Test kits are available at your Pool Care Chlorine Tablets Dealer.

METHODS OF APPLICATION: 1. Dispensing basket suspended in pool water. 2. Automatic in-line chlorinator. 3. Automatic in-line hypochlorinator. For best results, maintain pH of pool water between 7.2 and 7.8.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE TO MAINTAIN CLEAN, SANITARY SWIMMING POOLS

SWIMMING POOL SANITATION: Chlorine Tablets dissolve over extended periods of time instead of dissolving completely upon contact with pool water as does granular calcium hypochlorite. State and local health regulations usually require 0.6 to 1.0 ppm residual chlorine in public pool water. To maintain this safe level, use a daily or as needed dosage of 17 to 18 chlorine tablets per 5,000 gallons of water. Six Chlorine Tablets weigh approximately 1 oz. Increases in temperature, sunlight, organic matter, (such as leaves, grass, air-borne matter, etc.) and bathing load may necessitate the re-application of the given dosage more frequently to maintain the desired chlorine level. For accuracy under varying conditions, it is recommended that the treated pool water be tested with a test kit several times a day. Repeat above dosage as often as needed to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm residual. Test kits are available at your Pool Care Chlorine Tablets Dealer.

METHODS OF APPLICATION: 1. Dispensing basket suspended several inches below water surface. 2. Tablet hypochlorinator. For best results, maintain pH of pool water between 7.2 to 7.6.

ESTIMATING POOL CAPACITY

RECTANGULAR - Capacity in gallons equals length x width x average depth (in feet) x 7.5

ROUND Capacity in gallons equals diameter x diameter x average depth (in feet) x 5.878

DANGER: Fatal or harmful if swallowed. Strong Oxidant. May produce severe chemical burns. Fire may result from contact with heat, acids, organic or combustible matter. Do not get on skin or in eyes. In case of skin and eye contact, flush with plenty of water. If skin irritation persists, get medical attention.

ANTIDOTE: External - Wash thoroughly with water. For eyes, get prompt medical attention. Internal - Give milk, water, or egg whites. Call physician immediately.

"Not for use or storage in or around the home environment."

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by burying it with waste or burning. Stay away from smoke or fumes.

Keep cover closed when not in use. Use only a CLEAN DRY scoop made of metal, ceramic, plastic or glass. Keep away from heat, fire, combustible or other foreign materials*. Do not repackage. Never mix with other materials or use in dry form except in accordance with label directions. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Dispose of spilled Chlorine Tablets by immediate flushing with water. Store in the original container in a cool, dry place out of reach of CHILDREN.

*Some of the foreign materials which could cause fire are: oils, grease, paints, thinners, solvents, cosmetics, suntan lotions and creams, sugars, beverages, fertilizers, blood, sores, dead vegetation.
