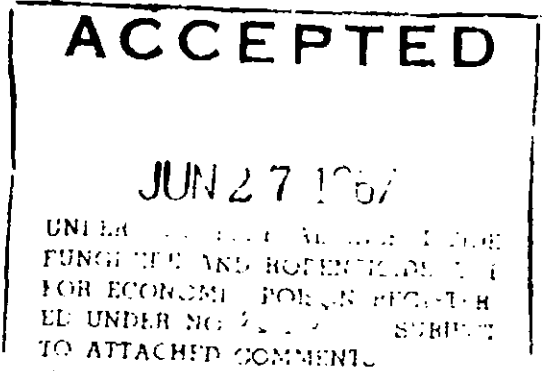

FOR SWIMMING POOLS LASTS ALL SEASON  
For Pools up to 12 ft.

Back Panel:

For round pools 12 feet in diameter (up to 2,700 gallons)  
One application of Permanent Algaecide will prevent the growth of most algae, adding a sparkle and brilliance, a clean fresh clarity which few other types of algaecides can offer.

INITIAL TREATMENT

Pool Care Permanent Algaecide must be added to algae free water. To insure this condition, super chlorinate pool for several hours prior to adding the algaecide. Allow the chlorine residual to settle back to normal before resumption of swimming.

DOSAGE: For initial treatment upon filling pool-Use:

- One gallon for each 10,800 gallons of water
- One half gallon for each 5,400 gallons of water
- One quart for each 2,700 gallons of water
- One cup for each 675 gallons of water

Using the dosage recommended above, apply the proper amount by pouring it in the pool as you walk around the edge.

WINTERIZING: Pool Care Permanent Algaecide will prevent the growth of most algae during the ~~winter~~ winter months if the dosage is maintained at recommended levels. However, it is suggested that the dosage be repeated prior to the winter months so as to insure the proper concentration of ~~algaecide~~ Pool Care Permanent Algaecide in the water.
