Problem Area	Pests	Rate and Area Covered	Notes
<i>Grass</i> Lawns: Bluegrass, Ryegrass, Fescue, Dichondra, Bent, Bermuda	Chinch Bugs*, Sod Webworms, Bermuda Mites, Ants, Ticks, Earwigs	2 tbsps. (1 fl. oz.) in 3 gals. of water covers 125 sq. ft., 8 fl. oz. in 24 gals. of water covers 1,000 sq. ft.	Thoroughly wet down grass a few hours before applying. *In the north, if Chinch Bugs are the only insect problem, a lower rate of application can be used: 2 tbsps. in 3 gals. of water covers 250 sq. ft.
Roses & Flowers: Roses, Azaleas, Chrysanthemums, Gladioli, Carnations	Aphids, Mites, Leafhoppers, Thrips	2 tbsps. (1 fl. oz.) per 3 gals. of water. Apply as a thorough foliar spray.	Spray underside of leaves. Wet plants to the dripping point.
Trees & Shrubs: Oak, Maple, Locust, Holly, Boxwood, Pine, Spruce, Willow	Aphids, Mites, Scale Crawlers, Leaf Miners, Bagworms	2 tbsps. (1 fl. oz.) per 3 gals. of water. Apply as a thorough foliar spray.	Wet leaves and branches to the dripping point. Try to penetrate dense foliage.
Nuisance Pests In Outside Areas: <i>VIII</i> <i>Outdoor</i>	Flies, Ants, Cockroaches, Boxelder Bugs, Clover Mites, Spiders, Ticks, Chiggers, Earwigs	Apply 8 fl. oz. per 3 gals. of water.	Thoroughly spray window frames, doors, sills, screens, porch and patio walls and ceilings, founda- tions, walks, garbage cans, and into cracks and other places where insects may hide. Do not treat plants or animals with this dosage rate.

(Note: Do not use on certain ferns, poinsettia, hibiscus, papaya, plian and gardenia, and orchids since injury may occur.)

Contains Diazinon[®] insecticide which provides positive control of many "hard-to-kill" sucking and chewing insects. Works fast and remains effective for an extended period of time.

HOW TO MIX AND APPLY: For lawns, measure the area to be sprayed. For all other applications apply as a thorough cover spray. Make applications when insects first appear, or in advance of an expected infestation. Repeat applications as needed or as noted in rate chart.

SPRAY AS DIRECTED IN RATE CHART: Use coarse drenching sprays for lawns, soils, and other surface applications. Use medium-fine mist sprays for trees and plants. Thorough coverage is important. Flush sprayer with clean water after each use.
