**STORAGE:** If container leaks or breaks, cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, and/or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent onto a shovel and put the sweepings into a suitable container for disposal. Take care to avoid contact with the pesticide or its vapors. Store at controlled room temperature between 15°C and 30°C (59°F-86°F).

**DISPOSAL:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse empty container, wrap, and dispose in trash receptacle, sanitary landfill, or other approved state and local procedure. Pesticide wastes are toxic. 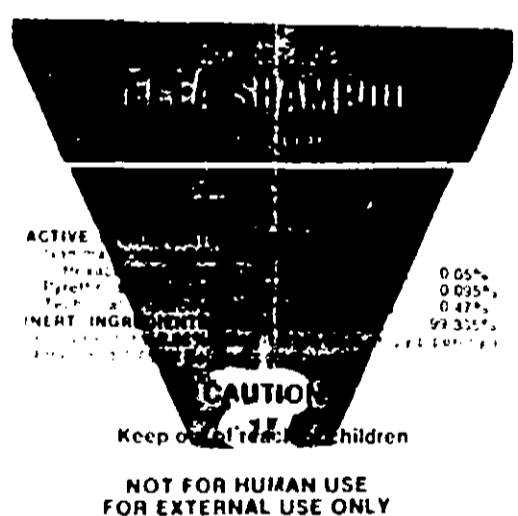

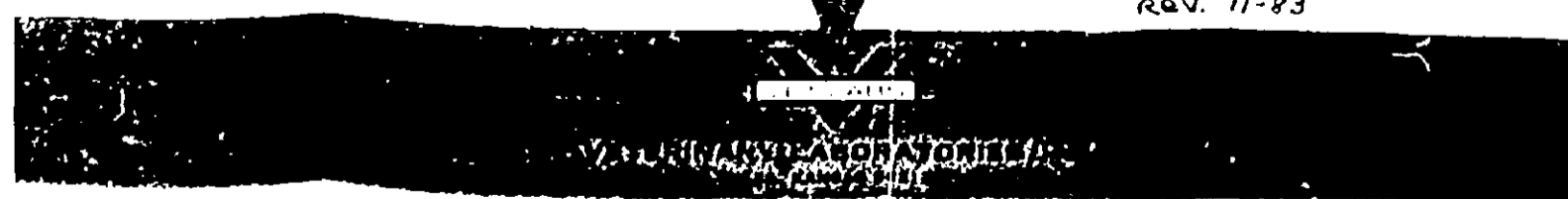

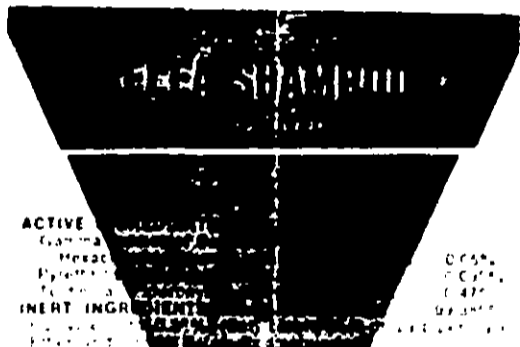

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT given is inadequate. We suggest the following statement, however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise, please submit a draft STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT for prior approval.

"STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed-Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled- Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin- Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water.

If in eyes- Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists."

2. Add the following to the "HAZAROUS TO HUMANS..." section:

"Do not use on puppies under three months of age."

3. Revise the first paragraph of the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZAROUS" section to read:

"This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife."

4. The RPAR Notice incorrectly indicated the language to be used for the RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE statement. Delete "For application only by or under the direct supervision of a certified applicator" and insert the following at the top of the front panel above the product name. (Note: the type size requirements for the heading "RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE" are the same as required for the front panel signal word.)

"RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE

For retail sale to and use only by Certified Applicators or persons under their direct supervision, and only for those uses covered by the Certified Applicator's certification."

5. The "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" should be moved to a position appearing immediately above the front panel signal word. It is preferred that this phrase be in all capital letters for maximum prominence.
6. Change the heading "DIRECTIONS" to "DIRECTIONS FOR USE".
7. Move "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling." to immediately follow the heading "DIRECTIONS FOR USE".
8. Add the following to appear in the "HAZARDS TO HUMANS..." section:
- "Wash hands with soap and water after use and before eating or smoking."

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you have a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until May 31, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
