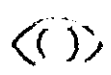

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT given is inadequate. We suggest the following statement, however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise, please submit a draft STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT for prior approval:

*STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed—Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING: vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
If inhaled— Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
If on skin— Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
If in eyes— Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN—Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally.

2. Revise the first paragraph of the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" section to read:
"This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife."

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3. The "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" should be moved to a position appearing immediately above the front panel signal word.
4. Change the heading "DIRECTIONS" to "DIRECTIONS FOR USE".
5. Move "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling." to immediately follow the heading "DIRECTIONS FOR USE".
6. Add the following to appear in the "HAZARDS TO HUMANS..." section:
"Wash hands with soap and water after use and before eating or smoking."
7. Add the following as the last sentence to the "TO CONTROL SCREW-WORM" directions:
"This will be noted by a lack of response to treatment."
8. Move the paragraph beginning with "WARNING: Contents under pressure..." to the "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" section.
9. Add the heading "PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS" to this section.
10. Change the signal word from ^{Caution} "WARNING" to ^{Warning} "CAUTION" in this section; the signal word must be consistent throughout the labeling.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until May 1, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
