



LIQUID CHLORINE OUTLET VALVE

1. Before opening valve, be sure packing gland nuts are snug. Check during use, tightening if necessary to prevent leakage.



LIQUID CHLORINE OUTLET VALVE

- 1. Before opening valve, be sure packing gland nuts are snug. Check during use, tightening if necessary to prevent leakage.
- 2. Check all connections for leaks, using ammonia.
- 3. Be sure valve is closed before removing outlet plugs.
- 4. Use an expansion loop between valve and unloading line.
- 5. Reduce pressure to under 100 lbs. before disconnecting.
- 6. When empty, close all valves and replace all plugs before releasing car.
- 7. The ball check valve, installed below the liquid valve, closes when there is a sudden surge of liquid in the line as might occur in case of a break, or if the liquid valve is opened too quickly. To release the ball to its open position, close the liquid valve and tap the manway plate.






