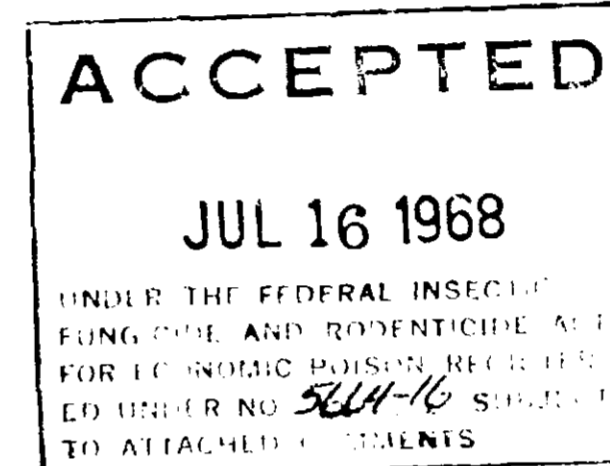

Invaluable for sanitary maintenance and in hotels, motels, restaurants, hospitals, etc.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

PHENICIDE is an amazing neutral product and is safe for any surface that water alone will not harm. It is recommended for use on rubber, asphalt, terrazzo, linoleum, marble, concrete, metal, or wood surfaces. It leaves a "Brilliant Finish" on all surfaces. It cleans as it disinfects.

FOR CLEANING AND DISINFECTING BADLY SOILED AND NEGLECTED SURFACES: Mop with solution of 3 ozs. to 6 ozs. PHENICIDE per gallon of water. Allow surfaces to remain thoroughly wetted for 5 to 10 minutes. Where possible agitate with scrubbing brush or mop. Remove with clean damp mop or squeegee.

MAINTENANCE CLEANING AND DISINFECTING (Mop Method): Use 3 oz. PHENICIDE per gallon of water. Mop thoroughly to wet surface and allow to remain wet 5 to 10 minutes. Pick up all dirty solution with clean, damp mop or squeegee.

Maintenance Cleaning and Disinfecting (Spray Method): This method recommended for cleaning large areas. Use 3 to 5 oz. PHENICIDE per gallon of water. Spray on area until surface is thoroughly wetted. Allow to remain wet 5 to 10 minutes. Pick up with clean, damp mop or squeegee.

FOR DISINFECTING AND CLEANING WOODWORK, FURNITURE, PAINTED WALLS: Use 3 to 4 ozs. PHENICIDE per gallon of water. Perpendicular surfaces should be cleaned from the bottom up, working in small areas.

CAUTION: Avoid contamination of food stuffs. May cause skin or eye irritation or be harmful if swallowed. Wash hands after using. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water.
