BACK PANEL

Sanipor cleans, disinfects and deodorizes toilet bowls, urinals and all vitreous surfaces, will not harm septic tanks.

DIRECTIONS

To clean and disinfect toilet bowls: Remove as much water as possible from bowl. Pour four (4) ounces SANIPOR around inside edge of bowl and allow to remain for several minutes, then brush under flush ring and around inside of bowl. Repeat operation until clean. After cleaning, rinse bowl by flushing.

Urinals: Saturate dry mop with SANIPOR and swab urinal until stains or discolorations have disappeared. Remove strainer, swab inside of drain. Keep wet for five minutes before flushing.

To disinfect floors around bowls & urinals: Non-porous surfaces such as Ceramic tile: Use four (4) ounces SANIPOR per gallon of water.
Porous surfaces such as concrete: use eight (8) ounces SANIPOR per gallon of water.

Keep all surfaces wet for five (5) minutes before rinsing, then wash with "TM" Neutral Cleaner. Do not use on marble nor on resilient floor coverings.

For daily cleaning of stainless steel coffee urns, sterilizers, stainless steel or plastic counter tops, dilute four (4) ounces SANIPOR with one gallon water. Apply with swab or brush. Rinse thoroughly immediately.

WARNING (18 point type)

Contains Hydrochloric Acid.

Corrosive: May be fatal if swallowed. Do not breathe vapor or fumes; may produce chemical burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

Antidote - Internal - Call a physician immediately. Drink a teaspoonful or more of magnesia, chalk or small pieces of soap, softened with water, in milk or raw egg white.

External - Eyes - Wash with water for 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention.
Skin - Wipe off acid gently, immediately flood the surface with water, using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.
