DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT! SHAKE BEFORE USE:

For besting shake between sprays. Point valve away from face and press button. Direct spray to control pests when possible.

DISPOSAL AND STORAGE

Wrap container and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture can.

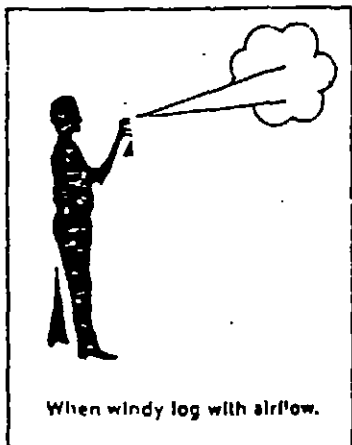
FOR CONTROL OF PESTS ON ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

Spray plants with a slow sweeping motion so that mist drifts into plants. Use caution around growth and tender foliage. Normal as necessary. When using outdoors spray when air is still.

For control of aphids, two-spotted spider mites, beetles and adult white flies on ornamental house and greenhouse plants (African violet, aralia, Christmas cherry, chrysanthemum, cineraria, dillenbergia, luscina, glorioia, ivy, lantana, Neanthe bella palm, petunia, rose and snap dragon and on outdoor plants: scales, chrysanthemum, nuchymus, ivy, marigold, pelonia rose, snap dragon and zinnia).

TREES AND SHRUBS:

GYPSY MOTHS, TENT CATERPILLARS also Canker Worms, Garden Webworm, Aphids, Spider Mites, and Adult White Flies on ornamental crabapples, cherries and plum trees, spray as above. Do not spray fruit bearing trees.

HORNETS-WASPS-YELLOW JACKETS

Kills Hornets, Wasps and Yellow Jackets nesting in ornamentals and trees and Shrubs, Rhododendrons, Yews, Laurels, etc. Fog preferably in the evening when air is still.

FOR CONTROL OF PESTS AROUND THE HOME

FLYING INSECTS (Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Moths) - Direct Spray at insects using short bursts (1 to 2 seconds) or treat unoccupied areas as follows: Close doors and windows. With a sweeping motion direct spray upward to all parts of the room (8 to 10 seconds per 1000 cubic feet). Keep room closed for 15 minutes and ventilate before reoccupying.

CRAWLING PESTS (Ants, Boxelder Bugs, Crickets, Earwigs and Sowbugs) - Spray into cracks or woodwork, walls, floors and other hiding and breeding places. Direct spray to contact pests when possible. Spray ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Do not use on or around animals. Cover or remove fish bowls for 1 hour.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before re-use. When using the product in these areas apply only when the facility is not in operation. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

Apply this product only as specified on this label.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS - STORAGE

Avoid breathing of vapor and skin contact. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact, flush with water. Do not smoke while spraying. Contents under pressure. Never set containers on stove or radiator or place where temperature will exceed 120°F.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD
