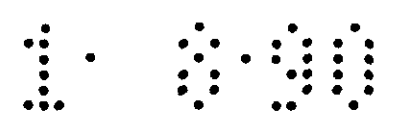


Not Reviewed. Registrant claims to be in accordance with reregistration of Pesticide Product Guidance for Phase 2 Response, Page 2.12, Active to Inert Change in Status.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner not consistent with its labeling.

"Spray with the wind to your back. If clothing becomes wet from spray during use, remove clothing after spraying. Wash affected body areas thoroughly with soap and water, and launder clothing before wearing again."

"Do not allow children or pets onto a treated area until the treated area such as grass or soil has dried."

"This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this pesticide or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area."

TO OPERATE: Hold can upright and spray infested surfaces only. Turn on spray pattern, press button down firmly, stream press button on in and out, and gently. Spray surfaces to coat and run off. Treated surfaces have a residual killing action for two to four weeks against insects. If reinfestations occur due to migrations or removal of the insect population by water or wear, repeat treatment.

ROACHES: Apply to crevices, joints, cracks, and baseboards. Spray into a cracks around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Also spray under and behind surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, etc. Spray other infested areas. Infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required.

SPIDERS: Use regularly indoors. Hold can farther up than 18" from surface to be sprayed. Spray to the edge of run off doors, windowsills, lamp, furniture, clothes posts, junction between foundation and house and other areas where they like to congregate.

FLIES: Spray spiders and their immediate vicinity.

MAGGOTS: To be in various stages can free of flies and maggots, only inside and outside frequently.

SPIDER: Apply indoors as a tick down spray to screens and s. where they are present.

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wild life. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by disposal of wastes. Apply the product only as specified on this label.

"This pesticide is highly toxic to birds, fish, and wildlife including waterfowl. Birds and waterfowl feeding or drinking in treated areas may be killed. Because of the migratory habits of certain waterfowl, do not apply this product to National Wildlife Refuges between November 1 and May 31. Do not exceed maximum recommended label rates. Rates above those recommended significantly increase potential hazards to birds and waterfowl. Avoid overlapping of sprays. Where irrigation is recommended apply a minimum of 0.25 inch of water immediately after application. Stop irrigation before puddling occurs. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries (except the influence from treated watercross beds). Do not apply to water that will be used for recreational purpose and human and livestock consumption. Snail and crab may be killed at application rates recommended on this label. Do not apply where fish, shrimp, crab, and other aquatic life are important resources."
