TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before being out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 5000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

Will Not Stain

This product will kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Black Carpet Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, small Flying Moths, Spiders, Centipedes, Fleas, Ticks, Wasps, Pill Bugs, Crickets and Silverfish.

For control of stored grain pests such as Saw-toothed Grain Beetles and Rice Weevils and destroy all infested food or feed products before fogging.

Aids in control of Cockroaches.

TO KILL TICKS: Destroy and replace pet's old bedding. Treat animal with a registered tick control product before re-entry.

TO KILL FLEAS

Use one can per 1000 cu. ft. of space.
