2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 5693-73."
- b. According to our calculations, the petroleum distillate content is 3.942 percent. At this level it would not likely be active. Please delete this item from the list of active ingredients on the label and add an appropriate amount to the percentage of inert ingredients.
- c. Please change the word scrotum to penitals or genitalia in the use directions, since female animals are also to be treated.
- d. The approved name for Carbaryl is 1-naphthyl . . . .

- e. Add a Statement of Practical Treatment as follows:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and water.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

- f. Include the following statement in the label text:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

- g. Add the statement: "Do not treat kittens and puppies under 4 weeks of age."  
h. The following statement must be placed in the use directions for dogs: "Do not use on pregnant dogs."

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

## BACK PANEL

### Precautionary Statements

#### Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

##### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Wash hands with soap and water after use. Do not spray in pet's eyes, face, scrotum, or open wounds. Do not use on nursing puppies or kittens under 3 months of age.

In the home, all food processing surfaces, exposed food and utensils, should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use.

Cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: DO NOT INCINERATE. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT

This product will kill Fleas, Ticks and Lice on Dogs and Cats. It will Repel Flies, Gnats and Mosquitoes from the animals.

Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under the body. As you spray, fluff the hair so the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets ticks thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes, face or on scrotum. Repeat weekly or as directed by veterinarian. Use in pet's sleeping area or on bedding, walls and floor to control reinfestation. Do not treat or cause exposure to kittens or puppies under four weeks of age. Do not use on pregnant dogs or cats.

For cats apply at the rate of one second per pound of body weight. For dogs apply at the rate of two seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short haired dogs and up to eight seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long haired dogs.
