- b. Add "Indoor Use Only" on the front panel and under the Directions for Use after "Shake well before use. Keep container upright."
- c. Remove hornets and wasps from the label. Data must be submitted or cited in support of the addition of these pests.
- d. Remove "and similar insects" from the list of pests. This is an ambiguous claim.
- e. Under the First Aid Statements, replace "Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow." With "Do not give any liquid to the person."
- f. Under "Precautionary Statements; Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals," modify to read:

"Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

- g. Under the subsection Physical or Chemical Hazards, Modify the text to read as follows:

**"Contents under pressure.** Do not use or store near heater open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

This product contains a highly flammable ingredient. It may cause a fire or explosion if not used properly. Follow the directions for Use on this label very carefully."

- h. Under "Directions for Use; It is a violation...labeling; Shake well before..upright", place the statements in the following order, separated form other text, as indicated:

"Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not use in food/feed...washed before use. Cover or remove exposed food. Non-food areas are areas such as..."

3. Submit acceptable Storage Stability (OPPTS No. 830.6317) and Corrosion Characteristics (OPPTS No. 830.6320) studies within 15 months of the date of this registration.

4. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before you release the product for shipment.

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If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. X 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. **Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.).** Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

**TO OPERATE VALVE:** To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all door and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

**To Kill Fleas and Ticks:** Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!
