Citrus to control Red Scale, Citricola Scale, Brown Soft Scale. Start spraying in spring. Do not apply 5 days before harvest. Peaches, Apricots, Nectarines. To control Peach Twig Borer, Plum Curculio, June Beetles, San Jose Scale. Do not apply to Apricots and Nectarines within 3 days of harvest, Peaches 1 day.
