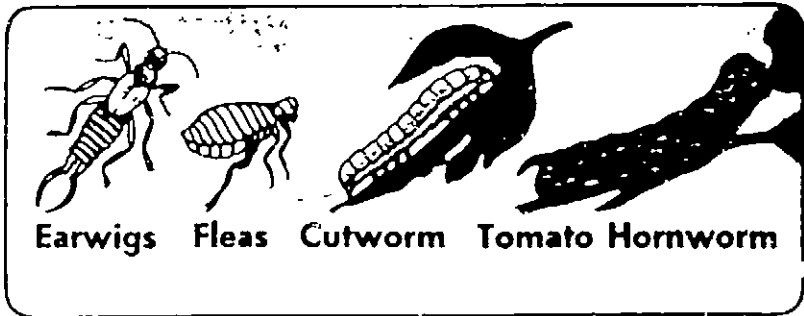

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION - Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing of dust. Avoid contact with skin. Avoid contamination of feed and food stuff. Keep out of reach of children.

Wear regular long sleeved clothing during application. Wash exposed skin with soap and water after use.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of water and induce vomiting. Get medical attention at once. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of fresh water. For skin, wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Note to physicians: Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to aquatic organisms. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply where run-off is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning equipment or disposal of wastes.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on crops. Protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. apply this product only as specified on this label. For best results apply when air is still. Dust upper and lower leaf surfaces. Apply to soil around the plant. Apply when insects first appear. Repeat as necessary.

Do not apply to Boston ivy or Virginia creeper. Injury to tender foliage may occur if plants are wet when treated or in the presence of high humidity.

ORNAMENTALS: Roses, Flowers, Shrubs, Trees, Woody Plants. For Japanese beetles, elm leaf fleas, June beetles, boxelder bugs, mealybugs, lace bugs, tarnished plant bugs, leafhoppers, leaf rollers, thrips (exposed), tent caterpillars, cutworms, earwigs.

VEGETABLES: Tomato, Eggplant, Peppers, To control tomato hornworm, tomato fruitworm, lace, stink and tarnished plant bugs, leafhopper. Use up to day of harvest.

Cucumber, Squash, Pumpkin, Melon. To control melonworm, cucumber beetle, flea beetle, leafhopper, squash bug. Use up to day of harvest.

Head Lettuce, Carrot, Cabbage, Broccoli, Cauliflower, Brussels Sprouts, Kohlrabi, Radish, Beet, Turnip. To control armyworm, flea beetle, leafhopper, cutworm, corn earworm. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest (except carrots, up to day of harvest). Do not apply within 14 days of harvest on leaf lettuce, Spinach and Swiss Chard. Do not treat Beets and Turnips within 14 days of harvest when tops are to be used as food.

Bean, Pea, Corn. To control leafhopper, grasshopper, armyworm, stink and tarnished plant bugs, cutworm, Japanese, flea and cucumber beetles. Use up to day of harvest.

Strawberries, Boysenberries, Raspberries, Blackberries. To control Japanese beetles, leaf roller, leafhopper, strawberry weevil. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

FRUITS AND NUTS: Apples, Pears, Walnut. To control apple aphid, pear psylla, codling moth. Do not apply to apples until 30 days after bloom or 1 day before harvest on apples and pears.

Peaches, Apricots, Nectarines. To control June beetle, leaf roller, plum curculio, codling moth. Do not apply to apricots and nectarines within 3 days of harvest, peaches 1 day.



Cherries, Plum, Prunes. To control mealy plum aphid, black cherry aphid, plum curculio, prune leafhopper, leaf roller. Do not apply within one day of harvest.

FOR USE ON DOGS AND CATS: To control lice, fleas ticks. Dust liberally over animal and rub thoroughly into skin. For brown dog ticks be sure to also apply on legs, feet and between toes. Comb out dead ticks a few hours after treatment. Keep dust out of eyes.

Do not use on puppies or kittens under four weeks of age.

IN AND AROUND DOG AND CAT QUARTERS: To control lice, fleas, ticks. dust liberally in and around sleeping quarters, kennels and dog houses. Force into cracks and crevices. Repeat at weekly intervals or as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (12 point)

STORAGE: Do not store product in a high humidity environment. Keep out of reach of children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
