For best results, spray plants from a distance of 1 1/2 to 2 feet using short bursts of 1 second. To prevent injury to plants, avoid visibly wetting the foliage.

Apply in the early morning or late evening when the air is still, treating all foliage including the undersides of leaves. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment every 7 days or as reinfestation occurs.

**FOR USE ON ORNAMENTALS** (African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, dogwood, geraniums, gladioli, marigolds, roses, rubber plants, Wandering Jew): to control Aphids, Flea Beetles, White Flies, Leafhoppers, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Stink Bug, Leafhopper, Fireworms, Blister Beetles, Webworms.
