Chacon Fire Ant Killer is a volatile product whose vapors are heavier than air. It kills ants in their nests by its anesthetic effect and by displacement of air from these areas.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazardous to Humans and Domestic Animals

WARNING

Avoid inhalation of vapors. Anesthetic effects may occur in the range of 0.1% concentration and death may occur if breathed. Vapors are heavier than air. Do not use indoors. Use only with adequate ventilation. Do not take internally. Avoid contact with skin. Keep out of reach of children.

Statement of Practical Treatment:

If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Professional medical assistance should be secured immediately. If inhaled, remove affected person to an area of fresh air. Give mouth to mouth resuscitation if respiration stops. Administer oxygen if available. Call physician and/or transport to a medical facility. It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply at the rate of 2 to 3 liquid ounces per mound by injecting the liquid through the mound opening or by carefully pouring this amount through the opening. For larger mounds increase the dosage up to 4 liquid ounces. For large mounds, in addition to pouring the liquid through the opening, spray 2 ounces around the top of the mound.

Do not disturb the mound more than necessary as a better kill is obtained when the ants remain in the mound. The rate of kill for Chacon Fire Ant Killer varies with temperature and with the amount of moisture in the soil. Do not treat mounds when the soil is saturated with water. A more rapid kill results in warmer weather.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (12 point size)

Storage: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
