FOR SANITIZING UTENSILS WASH OPERATIONS—

1. Pre-flush or pre-scrape to remove gross food if necessary.
 2. Wash thoroughly with water.
 3. Rinse with potable water.
 4. Sanitize in a solution of chlorine (1.5 ounces per gallon).
 5. Immerse all utensils for 10 minutes.
 6. Place sanitized utensils in a clean container for hand wash operation.
- For hand wash operation, the solution must be prepared at the time of use.

FOR SANITIZING UTENSIL SYSTEMS, ONCE-THROUGH SYSTEMS, ONCE-THROUGH SYSTEMS,

1. Pre-flush system.
2. Wash system thoroughly.
3. Rinse system thoroughly.
4. Sanitize in solution (1.5 ounces per gallon).
5. Allow equipment to air dry.
