## Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

**CAUTION: COMBUSTIBLE MIXTURE.**

Harmful if swallowed. Do not store, pour, spray, fog or use near heat or open

flames. Patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for 2 hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

When fogging indoors, all fires, flames, pilot lights and other sources of ignition must be extinguished and safely shut off. The National Board of Underwriters advises that not more than one gallon of any solvent-based formulation should be used to treat 100,000 cubic feet of space. Proportional quantities should be used to treat smaller or larger volumes. Do not breathe fog or spray. Wear suitable respirator when fogging indoors.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not apply space spray while food processing is underway. Food processing operations do not have to be stopped while applying a wet spray with care and in accordance with the directions and cautions indicated. Cover or remove all food before treatment. All food contact surfaces and utensils must be covered during treatment or washed before using.

### FOR INDOORS USE ONLY

**For Roaches, Silverfish.** Use a direct spray in such a manner as to reach places. Contact directly as many shelves, under sinks, refrigerator washers. Treat all returned before spray D-SECT daily.

During the summer months, use D-SECT for flies, mosquitoes and gnats. Ventilation systems before fogging equipment to prevent contamination. Disperse with an electric sprayer. Do not be used. Direct spray toward fly thoroughly fogged. Leave room. Do not remain in treated areas until removed. Remove and destroy dead as necessary.

**For Bed Bugs, Fleas and Brown Bats.** baseboards, bedding, rugs, quarters, kennels and bedding and insects as possible. Repeat at intervals.

Remove pets, birds and cover.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It's a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**FOR INDOORS USE ONLY**

**For Roaches, Silverfish.** Use a coarse wet spray that will not float in the air. Direct spray in such a manner as to penetrate all cracks, crevices and other hiding places. Contact directly as many insects as possible. Wet thoroughly around shelves, under sinks, refrigeration equipment, dishwashing machines and bottle washers. Treat all returned bottle cartons and cases. For badly infested areas, spray D-SECT daily.

During the summer months spraying twice a week is advisable.

**For Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats.** Close room and turn off air conditioning or ventilation systems before fogging. Remove exposed food. Cover food handling equipment to prevent contamination from spray. For best results in large areas, disperse with an electric sprayer, although hand or compressed air sprayers may be used. Direct spray toward the ceiling and continue spraying until area is thoroughly fogged. Leave room closed for at least 15 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Remove and destroy dead insects. Repeat D-SECT application as often as necessary.

**For Bed Bugs, Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks in buildings.** Spray lower wall portions, baseboards, bedding, rugs, carpets and floors of infested areas. Animal quarters, kennels and bedding should also be sprayed. Contact directly as many insects as possible. Repeat at least once a week or when reinfestation becomes evident.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
