FOR CLEANING Lightly soiled areas—mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1/2 gallon of water. Heavily soiled areas with fresh water. Heavily soiled areas—mop or brush with a solution containing 2-3 ounces of Citru Quat-3 per gallon of water. Rinse surface with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION Hard surfaces in schools, restaurants, and other public places may be treated with Citru Quat-3 per gallon of water. DEODORIZATION: To deodorize surfaces during cleaning, mop or brush surfaces with a solution containing 2 ounces of Citru-Quat-3 per gallon of water.

Citru-Quat-3 is an effective antibacterial cleaner designed for use in industrial and institutional cleaning. When used as directed, Citru-Quat-3 will disinfect hard surfaces, such as floors, walls, counter tops and furniture. It may be relied upon to deodorize bathroom areas, garbage pails, food storage areas, kennel areas and other areas where obnoxious odors may develop. This product may be used as a general purpose antibacterial-anti-fungal detergent in schools, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes, public rooms, food processing plants and in other places where efficient cleaning and antimicrobial action is desired.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL—PROHIBITIONS:

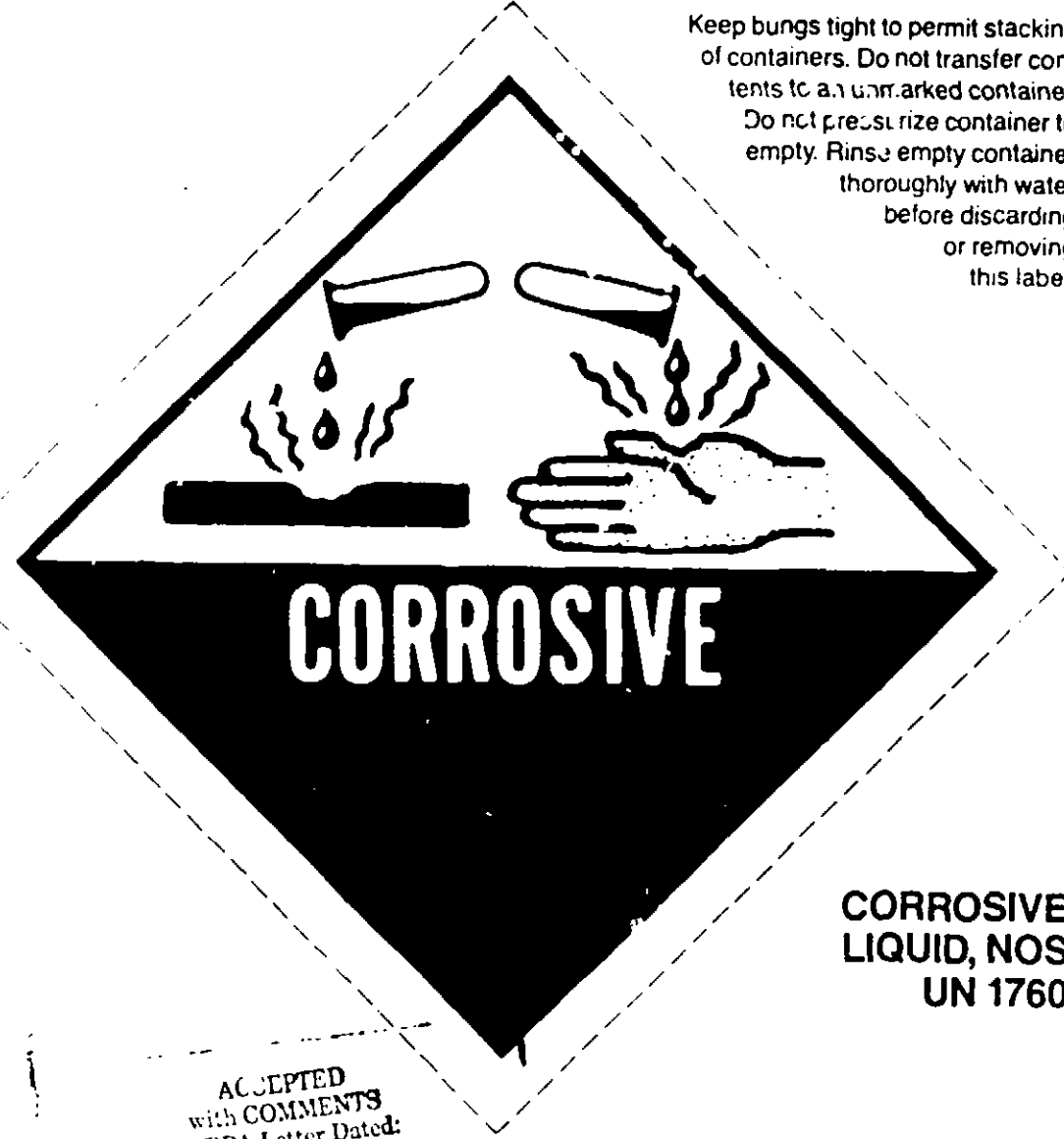
KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
