DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

CLEANING, DISINFECTING AND DEODORIZING TOILET BOWLS AND URINALS:

- With swab mop applicator, remove water from bowl by forcing over trap.
- Press swab mop against side of bowl to remove excessive water from applicator.
- Saturale swab mop with Bowl Cleanse (1-2 oz.) while holding applicator and bettla over bowl.
- Swab entire surface area especially under the rim where water outlets are located.
- Ailew Germicidal Bowl Cleanse to remain wet on surface at least 10 minutes
