When used as directed, Steriphene II Brand Disinfectant Deodorant is effective against the following pathogenic microorganisms on tables, countertops, bathroom fixtures and other hard, nonporous environmental surfaces:

Bacteria: Staphylococcus aureus, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Salmonella choleraesuis, Mycobacterium bovis

***Fungi:** Trichophyton mentagrophytes (causes athlete's foot).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Clean all surfaces prior to disinfection.

Disinfection and Deodorization: Shake well. Hold can 6 to 8 inches from surface and apply in a uniform mist film. Treated surfaces should remain wet for 10 minutes. Allow to air dry or wipe off.

Tuberculocidal Activity: Steriphene II Brand Disinfectant Deodorant is tuberculocidal under the above conditions in 10 minutes at 68°F (20°C).

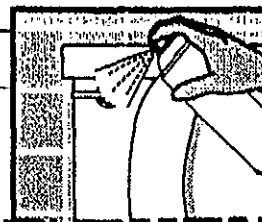
