c. Revise the Storage and Disposal Statements by including the following:

"Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place."

d. The following statement must be deleted from the master label until the product has been approved for such use:

"Consume Bio-Bowl contains viable bacterial cultures. Do not use this product on food contact or "human touch" surfaces such as countertops, toilet seats or bathroom fixtures (faucets, flush handles, door knobs, etc.). The bacteria in this product may cause infection if introduced into an open wound in sufficient quantity. Do not use in patient healthcare areas. Wash thoroughly after handling."

3. OPPTS Test Guidelines 830.6317 and 830.6320 - Storage Stability and Corrosion Characteristics, respectively must be conducted according to the guidelines under conditions of the Good Laboratory Practices (GLP). Therefore, within one year from the date of this Notice of Registration, you must submit Guidelines Studies 830.6317 and 830.6320 performed under GLP, as required.

4. You must submit a revised basic Confidential Statement of Formula, indicating the percent of active ingredient in columns 13 and 14.

5. Submit three(3) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

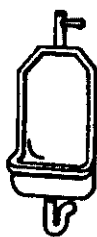

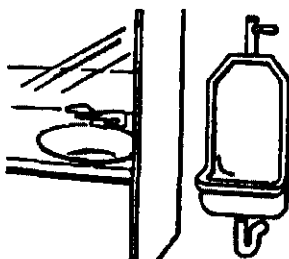
