 HOT SHOT WASP and HORNET KILLER provides rapid kill for HORNETS, WASPS, and YELLOW JACKETS when used as directed. This product is designed for outdoor use and in well ventilated attics, warehouses and other storage areas where foods and foodstuffs are not exposed.

DIRECTIONS
FOR OUTDOOR USE: Application should be made in late evening when hornets, wasps and yellow jackets are at rest. Hold can upright. Point valve opening away from face. With breeze at back, aim at nests. Do not spray in areas where foods and foodstuffs are exposed or handled.
FOR INDOOR USE: Point valve opening away from face. Aim directly at nests. Use only in well ventilated attics, warehouses and other storage areas. Do not spray in areas where foods and foodstuffs are exposed or handled.

APPLICATION: Thoroughly saturate nest with spray contacting as many insects as possible. To prevent insects from falling on skin and clothes, do not stand directly under nest. Best results can be obtained if nest is sprayed in late evening when most insects are at rest. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt, plastics, or rubber materials.
CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if swallowed, sprayed in eyes, inhaled or absorbed through skin. If swallowed, call a physician immediately. If sprayed in eyes, flush with water and call a physician. Avoid inhalation and provide adequate ventilation. Do not spray food, foodstuffs, water, dishes, or utensils. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment of these areas. Apply only when the facility is not in operation. Remove pots and cover fish bowls before spraying. Avoid direct spraying on vegetation.
